Red spiral-bound commonplace book\*  
Six-inch ruler

### History

1.5” D-Ring Binder (white)  
College ruled loose leaf paper  
Commonplace book\* (min. 70 pages)

### Music

Commonplace book & 2-pocket folder

Water bottle – labeled with name – no characters or pop culture slogans/stickers

Back pack – no wheels, characters, or pop culture slogans

Lunch box – labeled with name – no characters or pop culture slogans (disposable brown bags are also fine – label each day, please)

\*A commonplace book is another way to say notebook – it can be a spiralbound book, composition book, or journal. Look for college ruled pages and get what style noted in the list, please. If no color or style is noted – student’s choice (Latin will be purple and Literature gray).
